The Holy Spirit gives us the courage to see that we can do what Jesus asks us.

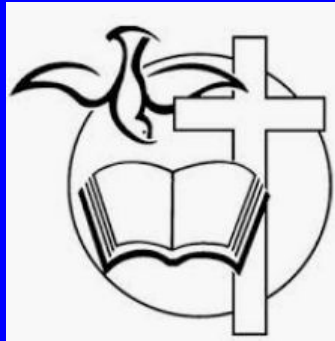
What does Jesus want us to do? How does Jesus want us to behave and treat people?

Protect me, Holy Spirit, that I may always be holy.

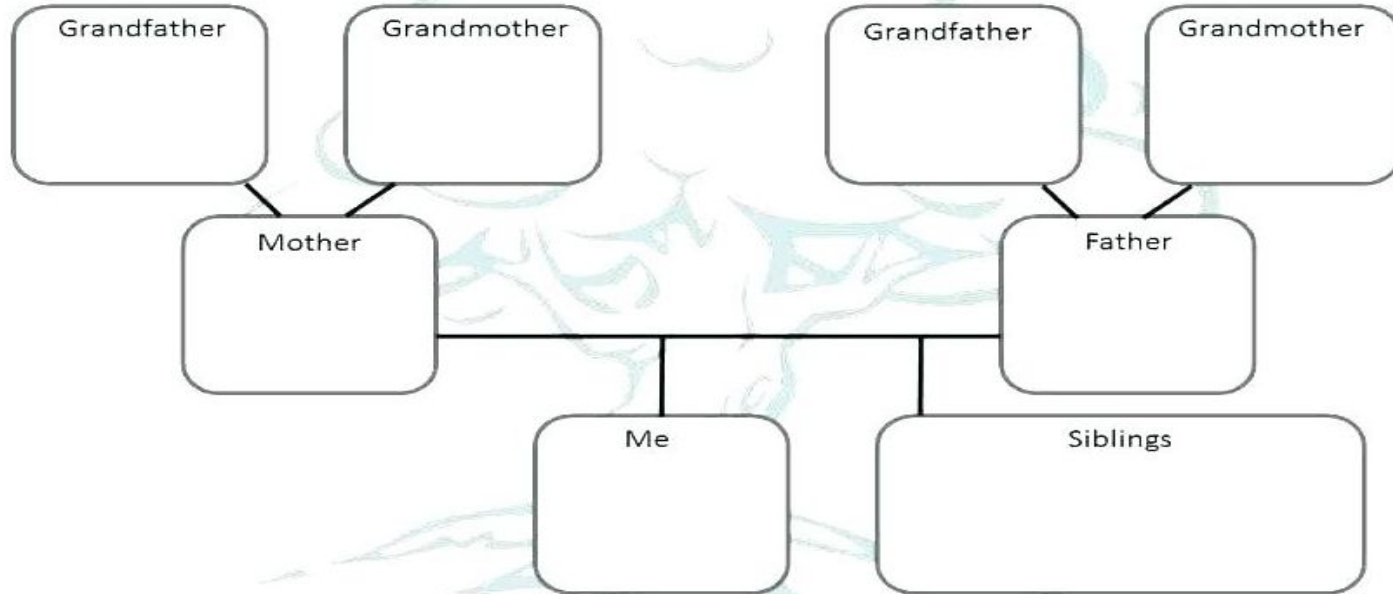

Talking Motions Pictures

Talking Motion pictures (movies) were created in 1910 by Thomas Edison (February 11, 1847 – October 18, 1931), who was an American inventor. This was the first time the movies included sound. As a result of his invention, movies as we know them today, were created. The motion picture was projected onto a screen and a phonograph was used to produce the sounds. One main problem was the synchronising of the sound and pictures at the same time. By the late 1920s, these problems were resolved, and cinemas were created. On April 15, 1923, at the New York City's Rivoli Theater, the first commercial screening of motion pictures with sound-on-film took place. People paid to watch the movie.

In 1927, the first Hollywood movie was released called "They Are Coming To Get ME". A film called "The Jazz Singer" was the first box office hit and was shown in England in 1928. One of the first British made films was "Blackmail" by Alfred Hitchcock, made in 1929. It had sound effects, a musical score (background music) and dialogue.

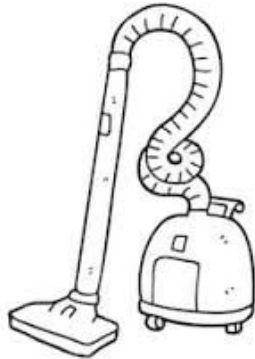
