## Change to Term Dates 2017-18

In November you were informed of the term dates for next year. Since then CAST have changed one of the staff training days that had been organised. #### After School Clubs

We are widening our range of after school clubs this term. A number of children have been invited to join the tag rugby club which I will run this half term on Thursdays. Plymouth Argyle coaches will continue to run clubs on Mondays and Fridays. This Friday the Argyle club will be for the same children as last term but a new cohort of children will then be recruited for Fridays for the rest of the term. The Forest School will continue to run on a Thursday for children. This term it will be for children already selected for year 2. The other clubs will be run by staff from TGS who already deliver PE sessions to the children in school. Thanks to the Sports Premium grant there will be no charge for these clubs.

The Monday Club this term will be for years 5 & 6 and will be based on team building and problem solving activities

On a Tuesday year 3 or 4 children will be able to join a rounders/cricket club.

On a Wednesday year 3 or 4 children will be able to basketball club.

On a Thursday children from the Foundation Stage will be able to join a multi sports skills club.

The Friday Argyle club will be football based and will be open to year 1 & 2 children.

All clubs will be limited to 15 children. Please return the reply slip below by the start of school on Thursday  $27^{th}$  so that the lucky children can be notified in time for the clubs to start next week. Please remember that this weekend is a Bank Holiday weekend so there will be no school, and therefore no clubs, on Monday  $1^{st}$  May.
