CLASS 6 trip to Burrator Reservoir on Wednesday 28th November 2018

On Wednesday 28th November 2018 Class 6 will be going to Burrator Reservoir. The children will travel to Burrator by coach, observe the water supply, sketch the human and physical features of the site, look at the change of land use and the water filtration system. The voluntary contribution requested for each child is £6.90. This cost includes transport. Please pay by Wednesday 21st November when a decision will be made whether the trip can go ahead or not. If there are not sufficient contributions we will not be able to go ahead with the trip. Please pay online using www.schoolmoney.co.uk or if you prefer to pay at a pay point please ask for a bar code to make your payment. If you think you may experience difficulties paying by the agreed date please see the class teacher or come to the office.

The children should wear home clothes. They should wear sensible walking shoes and bring a light coat/waterproof in case of rain. They will also need to bring a back pack to carry their own packed lunch or the packed lunch provided by the school kitchen in place of a school dinner. Please let the class teacher know on the reply slip whether you or the school will provide a packed lunch. Drinks must be in plastic bottles or cartons. Please no fizzy drinks, chocolates or sweets.

The coach will leave at 9.15 and will be expected back in time for the end of school at 3.30pm.
