Earlier in the week, we had our first child, who received GOLD for some outstanding maths work. Well done to Jaxon, who was able to solve a very complex maths problem that took me a good amount of time to work out the answer!

Please don't forget to sign up to meet your child's teacher. The sign-up forms are in the office or at classroom doors. It is important that you come along, so we can share with you how your child has started the year, how they are achieving academically, and offer some ideas for how you can support your child at home.

This October, once again, we will be supporting Plymouth PANTS Week in school (w/b 10th October.) Foundation and Key Stage 1 have already received a letter about this.

Through discussions and activities in class we will aim to teach our pupils important safety skills without giving explicit information or telling scary stories.

We will be teaching our pupils the NSPCC's, Talk PANTS rules using the 'PANTS' acrostic, which is like a green cross code for staying safe from sexual abuse. PANTS stands for:

- Privates are private
- Always remember your body belongs to you
- No means no
- Talk about secrets that upset you
- Speak up, someone can help
