Barton Hall

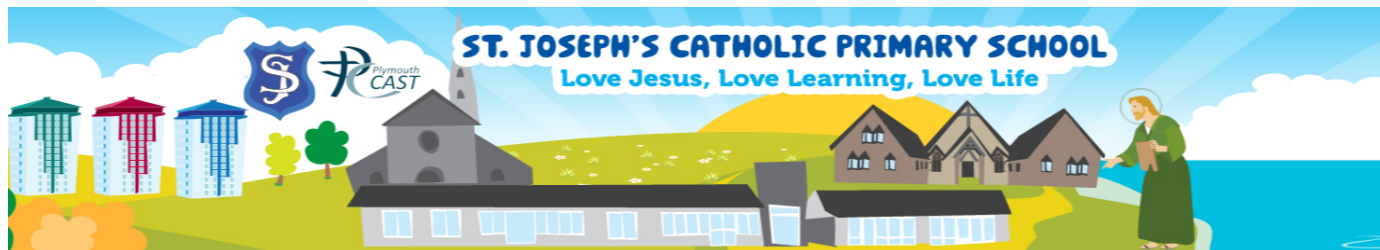
