“Those who accept my commandments and obey them are the ones who love me. My Father will love those who love me; I too will love them and reveal myself to them.”

And they show their love for us by comforting us when we are upset, by looking after us and by sharing their things with us too.

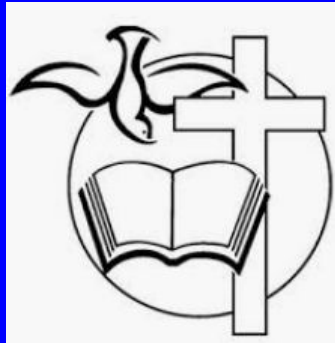
But we are all God's children. God loves each and every one of us because we are special. And so we need to do our best to show our love to all people, not just those who are close by.

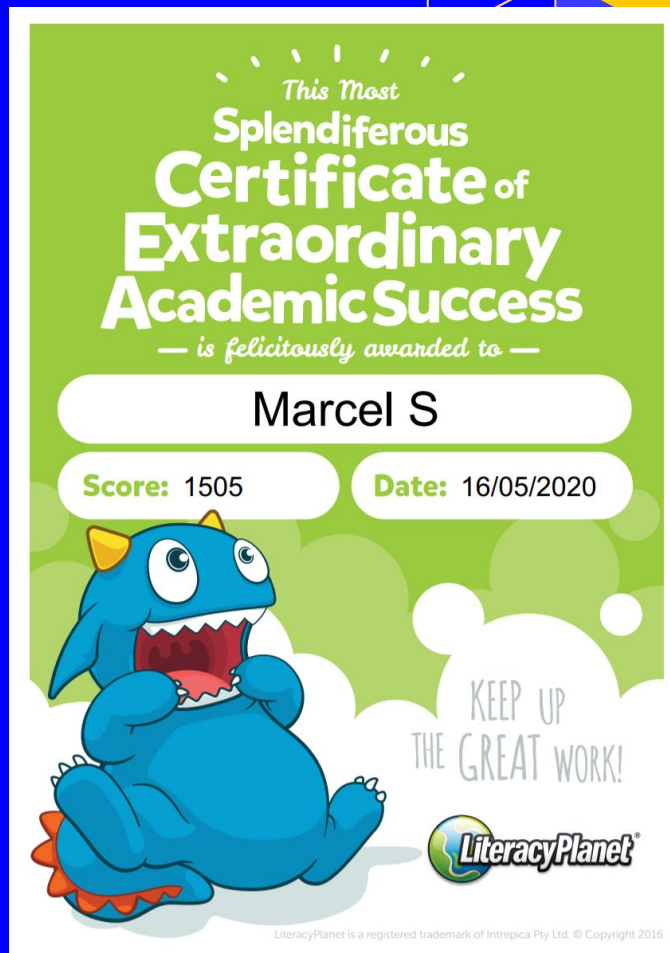

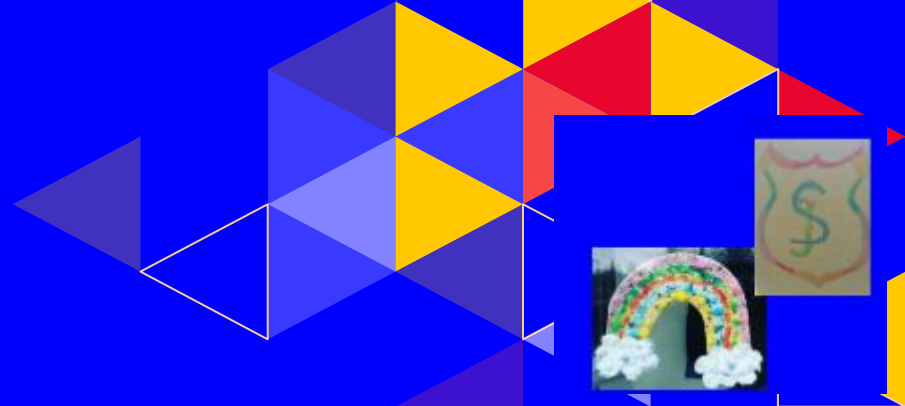

She has worked really hard on all of her home learning and never gives up.

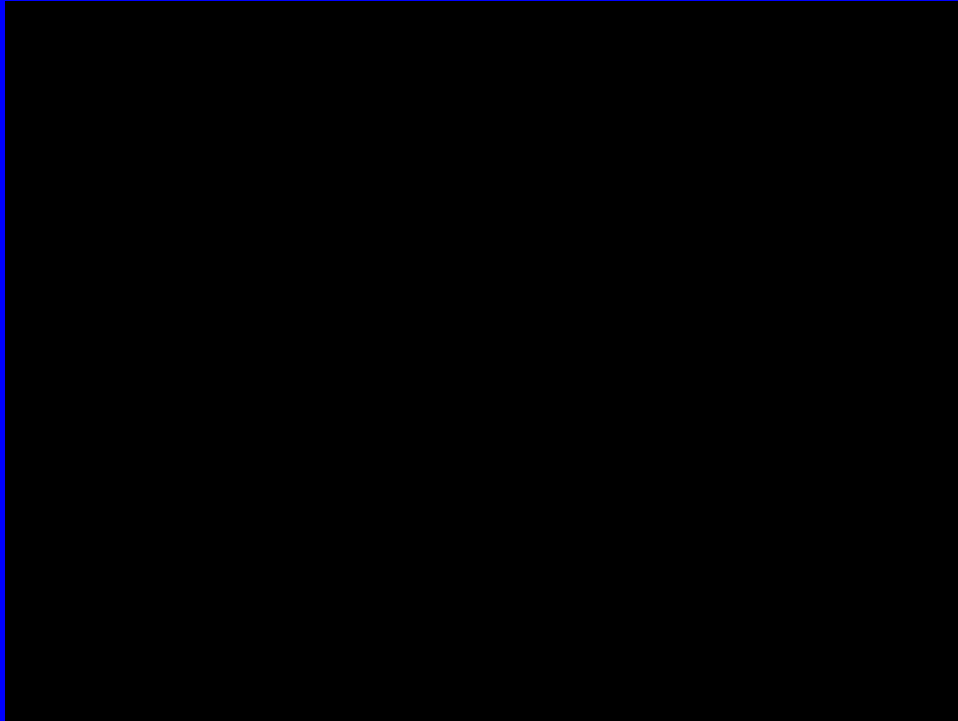
Sailor Sam keeps going until he has found what he is looking for and is not distracted.





Year 3

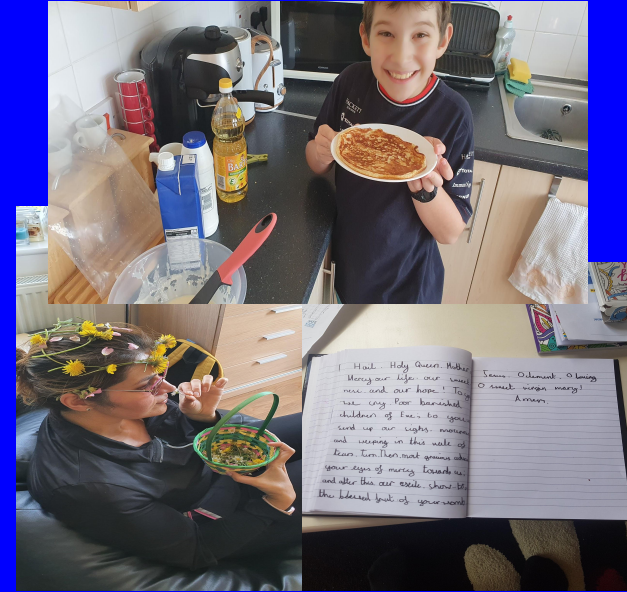
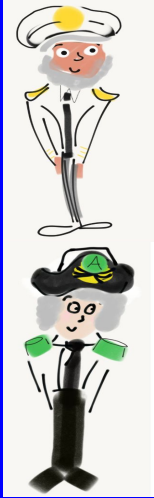
Ollie has been awarded a Sailor Sam crew member for his perseverance and dedication to his home learning. He has also shown some great Admiral Anne creativity skills.

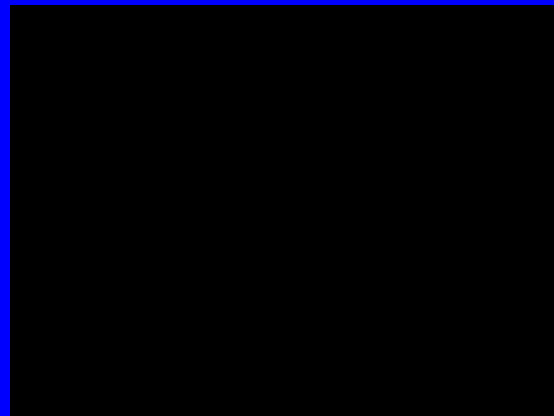


Sailor Sam Stamina!
